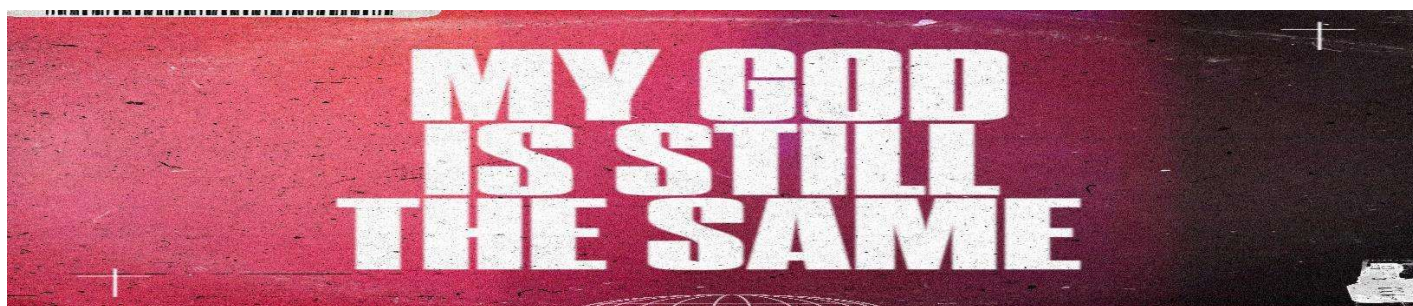

WHEN does MAX start and end? MAX begins Thursday, April 21 with a concert at 7pm. Sanctus Real & their My God is Still the Same Tour will be performing a concert on Thursday night at MAX. Here is the press kit link: www.sanctusreal.com/press-kit . MAX will end on Sat, April 23 early afternoon.

WHERE do I stay? The MAX Coordinators have a block of hotel rooms for each District. The Coordinators will assign housing as soon as we have all registrations turned in and will notify each participant. MO District participants will all be staying in the same hotel.

WHAT is the **COST**? Registration for Student Entrant is \$60; Registration for Adult Chaperone is \$40. This includes all events, speaker, concert, band, shirt, awards, & food (Fri. lunch & supper; Sat. brunch). Housing costs an additional \$40 per person (Adults will stay separately from students).
TOTAL COST: Student Entrant \$100. Adult Chaperone \$80.
